
Please note: The Pontoon road, Castlebar-Ballina road is closed (July 5<sup>th</sup>) due to road-works between the Crossmolina and Foxford junctions.

The Amplified traffic plan is drawn up to insure the least disruption to locals and smooth traffic flow on the approach and departure to/from the event. We are currently working with over 125 buses and if everyone follows the route set out there will be no delays. All junctions listed below will be marshalled and signposted on the day.
